- 3. Think about the results of your investigation. Was your question answered? If not, can you explain what happened? If yes, will you be able to convince others that your results are valid?
- 4. Plan your presentation. It should include
  - your original question
  - what others have discovered about similar or related questions
  - a description of your investigation (photographs, diagrams, or charts will be helpful)
  - the results of your investigation—your discoveries (charts, graphs, and/or tables will make your results more convincing)
  - additional questions that might be interesting to pursue later by you or others

When you present, try to relax. Speak slowly and loudly enough for everyone to hear. Repeat for your audience any questions asked by individual students.
